HKSH Healthcare Digestive Medicine Centre Offers Free Faecal Occult Blood Test for 3,000 HK Residents

(7 June 2016 – Hong Kong) To raise public awareness of colorectal cancer, especially among younger people, the newly opened HKSH Healthcare Digestive Medicine Centre is offering free faecal occult blood test for Hong Kong residents aged between 45 and 65.

On-line registration is now available until 31 August 2016 for 3,000 Hong Kong Identity Card holders on a first-come-first-served basis.

Colorectal cancer is one of the most common cancers in Hong Kong. Blood in stool can be a sign of cancer, polyp or other lower digestive tract abnormalities. "Faecal occult blood test is a simple and non-intrusive screening test for colorectal cancer," said. Dr. HSU Shing Jih, Axel, Specialist in Gastroenterology & Hepatology of HKSH Healthcare Digestive Medicine Centre.

"Colorectal cancer usually begins as a polyp and grows into a tumour in 7 to 10 years, making it preventable by early detection and removal of polyp. As colorectal cancer usually exhibits no obvious symptom, regular colonoscopy screening is essential and highly recommended, especially if people have family history of such cancer." he said.

Dr. CHAN On On, Annie, Specialist in Gastroenterology & Hepatology of HKSH Healthcare Digestive Medicine Centre added, "The free faecal occult blood test exercise has been extended to cover younger residents aged 45 and above as clinical evidence has shown that polyps were found in this younger patient group with some polyps having high risk of developing into colorectal cancer."

Successful applicants of the occult blood test will receive a confirmation email with specified time for picking up test kit in person at the HKSH Healthcare Digestive Medicine Centre in One Pacific Place, Admiralty. Stool sample should be collected in the dedicated container that will be provided to applicants and submitted for lab testing. To ensure accuracy, the test kit with stool sample should be returned to the Centre within three days of stool sample collection. The lab report will be ready within two weeks of sample submission, and participants will receive a notification email

for picking up the report.

If the test result is negative, no follow-up consultation is necessary. Nevertheless, participants with a negative test result should continue to stay alert of symptoms of colorectal cancer and seek medical advice as appropriate.

If the test result is positive, the centre staff will contact the participants to schedule a free consultation session with the specialist doctor to discuss the report with them. The participants can choose to pursue further colonoscopy investigation at the HKSH Healthcare Endoscopy Centre at a discounted price of HK\$8,880 (Original Price: HK\$9,800)


